
Preparing for a visit to the Musée d'art contemporain de Montréal

How to use this document?

This document is a user guide. It combines texts written in plain language with images. It helps you prepare for a visit to the Musée.

The user guide uses symbols.

Here is what the symbols mean:



How to get to the Musée?

The Musée d'art contemporain de Montréal is located in a shopping centre called Place Ville Marie, or PVM. It is situated at the corner of rue Mansfield and rue Cathcart. You can get to the Musée by two entrances to the shopping centre.







Access via rue Mansfield

Access via rue Cathcart



There is lots of traffic in the area. The streets are noisy.

Arriving with adapted transport



You are coming to the Musée by adapted transport.


The adapted transport brings you to **1, Place Ville-Marie**.

You are about 5 minutes away from the Musée.



You can enter the building using:

- the stairs
- **the ramp** that bypass the stairs on the right.



In the building, go to the **reception desk**. A reception or security agent will guide you to the Musée.

They will take you to an elevator. Then you will arrive in the shopping centre.

The shopping centre can be noisy. There are often lots of people.



Coming to the Musée by car



You can come to the Musée with your own car.

You can park in the **paid parking** for the Place Ville Marie shopping centre. Access to the parking is by **rue Cathcart**.



You can also park on the street close to the Musée.



You can also park in the parking spaces reserved for people with reduced mobility:

- On rue Mansfield, facing the access to the PVM shopping centre
- At the corner of rue Cathcart and avenue McGill College
